I. AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

The school attracts great importance to a varied programme of activities outside the ordinary class routine. These are designed to develop important traits of character like honesty, self-confidence, co-operation, diligence and to promote latent talents for leadership and responsibility. A proper use of library facilities, study circles and clubs, debates, elocution, quiz contests, theatre arts, music, dance, abacus, martial arts, school picnics are some of the co-curricular as well as educational activities.

All students are given a comprehensive course in Value Education and Faith Formation. In teaching the Humanities and the Science, the aim is to impart an integrated, theoretical and practical knowledge based on the latest techniques and the requirements of the syllabus of the Central Board of Secondary Education. Games and physical training have an appropriate place in the Time table.

Physical training, games and athletics are encouraged to promote sportsmanship and a healthy spirit of competition.

The school has ample playing fields, for Football, Basketball, Volley ball and Throw ball. While a competent member of the staff is always present to give advice and guidance, the fullest scope is given for initiative and leadership among the students themselves. Coaches will be employed by the school for the purpose of giving specialised training to the students. Keeping in mind the harmonious development of each student, we also offer, through our teachers, a variety of hobbies to the students. Training is conducted during school hours, as well as after school, during which attendance is compulsory. Inter- House Competitions are held regularly, to give impetus to culture and creativity.

School Counsellor / Special Educator: the school counsellor is available to students and parents with prior appointment.

children understand that a well – ordered and disciplined way of life is as important at home as in school. Parents should supervise their lessons, and take an active interest in the activities of the school.

- 2. a) Parents are informed that occasional reports from teachers are made in the school diary and they are requested to sign them.
- b) A fine of Rs. 150 will be charged if the student loses the School Diary.
- 3. a) Absence from school even for a day must be noted in the "Student's Leave Application form" given in the School Diary. If absence lasts for more than three days the application for leave must be made to the Principal accompanied by relevant certificate / reason of the same.
- b) If a child has an infectious disease parents should keep the child at home till he/she recovers. A medical Certificate and Fitness Certificate must be submitted on return.
- c) Students who are absent on the first and last day of any term, or who are away from school for five consecutive days without permission, may have their names removed from the register, and will be re-admitted only if there is a vacancy. In all cases of leave of absence, prior permission from the Principal should be obtained, except in cases of unforeseen circumstances, for which an authenticated reason should be furnished by the parent or guardian. However, granting of leave is entirely up to the discretion of the Principal. If a student from Class X is absent, She/he has to meet the Principal along with his/her parents on the day of his/her return.

Long leave from school for marriages, vacation, family functions, will be sanctioned only by the principal, with prior permission. Leave from school must not be prefixed to school holidays.

- 4. Parents are requested to refrain from requesting for permission to take their wards out of school during school hours for flimsy reasons. If the wards are found unwell or unusually tired they must be allowed to rest at home.
- 5. Change in the address or telephone number of parents or guardians must be intimated to the school in writing, without delay.
- 6. When communicating with the Principal, parents are requested to mention in their letter the Class, Section and Admission No. of their child/children.
- a) Parents are welcome to visit the school and meet teachers after school hours (3:45pm) with prior permission of the Principal or Coordinators. Any clarifications relating to academics, if any, may be made either to the Coordinator or teachers.
- b) Parents can meet class teachers every month on a Saturday, in their respective classrooms.
- 7. a) The school reserves the right to suspend or to take strict disciplinary action against a student whose diligence or progress in studies is constantly unsatisfactory or whose conduct is harmful to other students.
- b) The observance of rules of discipline of the school and good behaviour is an essential condition to a student's continuance in the school. In case a student violates the school rules or indulges in any form of indiscipline, strict action like expulsion/ suspension/ rustication shall be taken against the student.
- c) Students are strictly forbidden to bring or burst crackers in the school and to introduce objectionable literature and other such material into the School. Strict disciplinary action will be taken against the student found doing so.
- 8. Whenever excursions and picnics are organized by the school, maximum participation by students is expected. All outings are under the supervision of school staff.
- 9. a) The school is not responsible for goods lost. Therefore, it is not advisable to bring expensive items like watches, fountain pens, gold or silver ornaments, friendship band any other fads or too much money. Students are also advised not to leave any of the above in the class room or changing room.

- b) Students are not permitted to wear any expensive jewellery.
- 10. Fine of any kind or collection or sale for any purpose whatsoever requires the prior sanction of the Principal is needed.
- 11. Presents to members of the staff or other demonstrations in their honour also require the Principal's prior sanction.
- 12. Mobile Phones, I-Pods, MP3 Players, Pen drives etc; are strictly forbidden in the school campus. Parents must ensure that their wards do not bring any of the above gadgets to the school. If your ward is found carrying them, the same will be confiscated and will not be returned. In case of emergency, a student may approach the school office to speak to his/her parent with a permission of the co-ordinator.
- 13. Any electronic device that can be used for communication / photography/recording is strictly forbidden.
- 14. Celebrations of birthday parties in school are not permitted.

III. ADMISSIONS:

- 1. The management reserves the right to admit or refuse pupils seeking admission to the school. Similarly, the Management decides when the question of retaining a student in the class arises.
- 2. No child less than 4 years old on the first day of the academic year 31-05-2024 will be admitted to L.K.G and 3 years for Pre KG. At the time of admission, the following certificates should be attached with the application form:
- a) A copy of the Birth Certificate (once admitted: NO CHANGE IN DOB WILL BE ENTERTAINED WITHOUT THE REQUIRED DOCUMENT)
- b) Health/immunization Certificate.
- c) Original Transfer Certificate from the school last attended (From Std. II onwards).
- d) A photocopy of Aadhar Card of student & parents
- e) Income Certificate.

- f) Caste Certificate.
- g) Copy of the Bank pass book.
- h) A colour photograph of a student.
- 3. Pupils seeking admission for all the classes may be tested on the syllabus of the standard below the one to which they seek admission.
- 4. Admission is formally completed only when the form has been filled up and submitted to the office, fee dues are paid and the form is signed by the Principal. Payment of fees, writing the entrance test or an interview does not necessarily mean that admission is granted.
- 5. Admission cannot be claimed as a matter of right. Any attempt to use influence, unfair means or recommendation for admission, will lead to automatic disqualification. The school does not have any agents for admission.

IV. PROMOTIONS

- 1. Promotion to the next class depends on the whole year performances, on regular attendance, on the overall development and the ability to cope with the next step in the Student's Education.
- 2. Evaluation of the academic performance will be based on the tests and examinations conducted and the assignments allotted from time to time.
- 3. Only those students with a minimum of 90% attendance of the working days during each academic year will be considered for promotion.
- 4. Absentees at an examination will be considered as having failed unless it is established that their absence was due to illness.
- 5. No special arrangements will be made for pupils who for any reason are absent from the examination and there is no provision for retests.
- 6. The decision of the school authorities will be final with regard to promotions.
- 7. The school will not retain the answer scripts of the students beyond 15 days from the date of the examination.

8. The school will not be responsible for parent's failure to see the progress report of their wards. Report Cards are to be signed only by parents/guardians on the Report Card day.

V. WITHDRAWALS

- 1. Application for Transfer Certificate must be given in writing in the prescribed form by the parents. A calendar months' notice of withdrawal must be given.
- 2. If a student is not going to continue in the school for the following academic year, the school office should be informed in writing before the 20th on February. Otherwise transfer certificate will be issued only on payment of First term fees.
- 3. In the event of withdrawal of a student from the school, all dues must be cleared before the Transfer Certificate is issued.
- 4. Transfer Certificate will be forwarded to the school where in the child is admitted.
- 5. A fee of **Rs. 200**/- will be charged for the Transfer Certificate.
- 6. The Application for T.C. should be signed by the Parents/Guardian only.

VI.DISMISSALS:

- 1. The school management reserves itself the right to dismiss students who continuously fail to make satisfactory progress in their studies or whose conduct is, in a way, detrimental to the orderly life of the school.
- 2. Use or attempt to use unfair means in exams, tests and assignments are sufficient cause for dismissal.
- 3. Students who indulge in political propaganda or who organize or influence fellow students for political faction in the premises of the school, or who otherwise engage themselves in party politics are liable to be expelled from the school.
- 4. The wards of those parents/guardian who obstruct the smooth functioning and vitiate the academic atmosphere of the school through their act of omissions and commissions shall be liable to be dismissed from the school
- 5. Smoking, bringing and consuming alcohol or narcotic drugs disrespect towards the staff, bad moral influence, contempt of authority and wilfully damaging school property will lead to the dismissal of the students from the school.
- 6. A student repeating a class for two consecutive years will be asked to be withdrawn from the school.

VII. FEERULES

- 1. All fees should be paid strictly as scheduled through online only, no hard cash/liquid cash accepted.
- 2. Registration and Cancellation for Transportation facility should be mandatorily informed to School Office, late information will not be considered.
- 3. A delay beyond two months in the payment of fees leads a student's name to be struck of the rolls.
- 4. If fees are not paid within 30 days from the due date or not excused by a special arrangement, students are liable to be sent home without prior notice or warning.
- 5. No deductions are made for vacations or broken periods.
- 6. Pupils will not be allowed to appear for term or final examinations unless the fees have been paid.
- 7. In the absence of a calendar months' notice for withdrawal of a student, one additional instalment of fees will be payable without any consideration for any broken period.
- 8. Fees can be paid in 3 instalments or at one time at the beginning of the academic year.
- 9. There may be an annual increase of 10-20% in fees every year.
- 10. The fee schedule and other changes are intimated to the parent separately and may change when necessary.
- 11. If fees are not paid on or before the stipulated date fine of Rs. 100/- will be charged for every succeeding month.
- 12. Fees once paid will not be refunded. The following are the dates of payment of the school fees.

IX.CODE OF CONDUCT IN SCHOOL

- 1. Punctuality and regularity in attendance, proper school uniform, and gentlemanly and ladylike behaviour in and outside school is always expected of every Mattians. In all these matters, the parent's co-operation is expected at all times.
- 2. Pupils must stand up smartly and greet teachers who enter the classroom and leaves the classroom.
- 3. Honesty is expected of every pupil. If a pupil finds something which does not belong to him/her, he/she should inform the Class Teacher/ Coordinator about the articles found and leaves the same in the office. Pupils who lose the article may also inform enquire about them in the School office.
- 4. Students are not allowed to leave the school premises without getting a gate pass duly signed by the Principal/ Coordinator of the respective section.
- 5. Damage to school property, however small, will not be condoned. Stringent disciplinary measures will be taken against such offenders. The parents will have to bear the expenses of the damaged property.
- 6. Students are answerable to the school authorities for their conduct in and outside the school. Hence, misbehaviour in public places and conveyance justifies dismissal. Irregular attendance, habitual idleness, disobedience, objectionable moral behaviour and above all discourtesy and disrespect to teachers are sufficient cause for dismissal from school.
- 7. On their way to and from school, students must remember that the school is judged by their conduct. They should greet the visitors and the teachers of the school when they meet them.
- 8. During the absence of the teacher from class, students must obey the prefect silence, Monitor and Monitress appointed to maintain order and discipline.
- 9. Every student must take part in Physical Training and Games, unless declared unfit on medical grounds or exempted by the Principal. Students are forbidden to join any outside sports organization without permission from the Principal.

X. LIBRARY RULES:

- 1. Strict silence should be observed by all in and outside the Library.
- 2. All articles not pertaining to the library should be kept outside.
- 3. Nobody should enter the library without his/her library Card.
- 4. Only one book will be issued per card and no student can take a book on another's card.
- 5. Books can be returned only on the respective library days.
- 6. Books overdue may be returned on any library day, with a fine of Rs.5 per day.
- 7. No fine will be charged for books overdue if a letter is being produced, showing the borrower has been absent for valid reasons.
- 8. If any defect is noticed when taking a book, it should be brought to the attention of the librarian.
- 9. Books lost must be replaced by the borrower. In case the book is not available, the cost of the book will have to be deposited at the School Office.

XI.RULES FOR STUDENTS USING PRIVATE TRANSPORT

- 1. Students are not permitted to come to school in self-driven vehicles except bicycle. If they are found doing so they will be liable for suspension.
- 2. Every student's mode of transport should be recorded in the school office and in this hand book.
- 3. Students who reach late should contact the Physical Education Teacher. No entry will be permitted after 9. 10 a.m.
- 4. Three late arrivals would lead to the student being sent back home.
- 5. No student is permitted to take lift from any person in his/her bikes/cars without the prior permission of the school authorities. It is very dangerous to take lift from strangers who encourage you to ride with them with a promise to reach you home.
- 6. To make the school premises plastic free zone, every student and teacher is recommended to **bring only non-plastic Tiffin containers and Water bottles.**
